

Alaska Fly Fish & Kayak Trip

May 23-29, 2010 :: Gustavus, Alaska

This adventure promises to be much more than just a fishing trip or kayaking expedition. Whisper Marine and Spirit Walker Expeditions (both based in Gustavus, Alaska) are combining to offer a unique wilderness adventure along the Outer Coast of Southeast Alaska. Our initial destination lies 100 nautical miles west of Juneau. We will paddle and powerboat an additional 40 miles, in an area of the Tongass National Forest that sees very few visitors and has no roads.

For fishermen, the trip includes fly-fishing and casting in streams where Steelhead, Cutthroat and Rainbow Trout, Dolly Varden and Salmon thrive. The area is also a photographer's dream. Humpback and gray whales, sea otters and sea lions, seals, river otters, deer, eagles, and bear populate the rugged coastline, inland meadows and rainforest. We'll explore tidal pools and an abandoned mining town, and soak in a hot springs, right at the ocean's edge! Each evening, we'll relax by the campfire, as our guides prepare delicious meals.
